

Automatic Sanctioning in a “Normal” season Policy 12.4.3	Changes for 2020-21 Covid Season
✓ Game play between September 1 and March 31	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ AHS Covid protocols/facility guidelines <u>must</u> be followed for participants</li> <li>✓ Review Ringette Alberta’s Return to Ringette Supplement</li> </ul>
✓ Team training (on ice or dryland) between August 15 and March 31	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ AHS Covid protocols/facility guidelines <u>must</u> be followed for participants</li> <li>✓ Trainers are recommended to physically distance and wear a mask if not in the cohort</li> </ul>
✓ Specialized athlete development programs (introductory programs, goaltender training, power skating)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ AHS Covid protocols/facility guidelines <u>must</u> be followed for participants</li> <li>✓ Specialized trainers are recommended to physically distance and wear a mask if not in the cohort</li> </ul>
✓ Team building activities that do not expose participants to any risk which is greater than what they would experience in a typical ringette game	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ AHS small gathering and safety protocols <u>must</u> be followed by participants</li> <li>✓ <b>Only cohort participants are permitted to participate in team building activities (review the Ringette Alberta Return to Ringette document for cohort definition)</b></li> <li>✓ Team building activities – recommend physical distancing, wash/sanitize hands frequently, do <u>not</u> share food/drink</li> <li>✓ Meals/Snacks - Follow facility guidelines for restaurants. Wash/sanitize hands frequently, do <u>not</u> share food/drink</li> <li>✗ <b>Team sleepovers are not permitted at this time</b></li> </ul>
✓ Exhibition games between teams registered with Ringette Alberta	✓ Exhibition games <u>MUST</u> be scheduled through the Leagues. <i>Return to Ringette supplement version 2 (coming soon) defines league, exhibition and shinny/ scrimmages</i>
✓ Athlete evaluations starting no sooner than the Sunday of the weekend prior to the labour day long weekend for the season commencing in the same calendar year as the evaluations	✓ No change
✓ Come Try Ringette events where the participants are preregistered (before they begin the related activities)	✗ <b>Come Try/Bring a Friend events are <u>not permitted</u> until further notice</b>
✓ Association / Team end-of-season banquets where NO alcohol is served or consumed	✗ <b>Banquets are <u>not permitted</u> until further notice</b>
✓ Provincial Playdowns and Championships	✗ <b>TBD</b>
✓ Team travel to Out of Province Tournaments which are sanctioned by a Member in Good Standing of Ringette Canada	✗ <b>Out of Province team travel is <u>not permitted</u> until further notice</b>
